Their petition for a union election was filed today with the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) office in Region 18, Minneapolis, MN.

In exercising their right to vote, the professional and non-professional staff at Carmen Schools of Science and Technology seek to bargain collectively and achieve a negotiated agreement that will address numerous workplace issues. Four of the primary goals of their union drives are: equity, a sustainable workload, transparency, and financial fairness.
